

TERMS AND CONDITIONS - ATMC2022 Ticket Competition

1. Eligibility: The Australian Tactical Medicine Conference 2022 (ATMC22) Ticket Competition is open only to those who purchase an individual full-price or individual members-price ticket to the ATMC22. The definition of "Individual ticket" for The ATMC22 Ticket Competition is any singular ticket purchased in a single transaction with only one attendee's name in the ticket details. Volunteers from the Australian Tactical Medical Association (the "Sponsor"), their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, suppliers and their immediate family members and/or those living in the same household of each volunteer are not eligible to participate in The ATMC22 Ticket Competition. Group ticket purchases do not constitute an entry into The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, and no ticket that is purchased to ATMC22 as part of a group ticket purchase will be part of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition. The definition of "Group ticket" for The ATMC22 Ticket Competition is more than one ticket purchased in a single transaction. The ATMC22 Ticket Competition is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited.

2. Agreement to Rules: By participating in The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, you agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these Rules, and you represent and warrant that you meet the eligibility requirements set forth herein. In addition, you agree to accept the decisions of the Australian Tactical Medical Association as final and binding as it relates to the content. The ATMC22 Ticket Competition is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

3. Competition Period: All Individual tickets purchased to attend ATMC22 from (4th May 2022) up until 21 August 2022 11:59 PM AEST will constitute an entry into The ATMC22 Ticket Competition. All entries must be received by 21 August 2022 11:59 PM AEST.

4. How to Enter: The ATMC22 Ticket Competition must be entered by purchasing an Individual conference ticket at either full price or members price before 21 August 2022 11:59 PM AEST. The entry must fulfil all of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition requirements, as specified, to be eligible to win a prize. Entries that are not complete or do not adhere to the rules or specifications may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Australian Tactical Medical Association. You may enter only once, and you must fill in the information requested through the registration portal. If you use fraudulent methods or otherwise attempt to circumvent the rules, your submission may be removed from eligibility at the sole discretion of the Australian Tactical Medical Association.

5. Prizes: Winners of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition will receive one of three prizes as stipulated herein; The First prize recipient will receive three nights of accommodation for the night of the 14th, 15th and 16th of September 2022 at the Pullman King George Square hotel for one person valued at \$825. The winner will be entitled to a basic single bedroom; in the unlikely event the Pullman King George Square hotel is unavailable, a basic single bedroom at the Mercure King George Square will be awarded. In the event the recipient cannot attend throughout the stipulated time period, the accommodation cannot be moved, and the value of the accommodation prize cannot be refunded to the recipient under any circumstance. The recipient will be liable for all extra costs associated with the stay, including fines, damages and use of non-complimentary services. The second prize recipient will be awarded a refund of their conference ticket price; the total price refunded to the winner will be the total amount of a single Individual ticket price that the winner has paid only. Any other costs associated with the original purchase will not be refunded. The total value of the second prize may vary but will not exceed \$500. The refund of costs associated will occur no later than the final day of the conference, 16 September 2022. The third prize recipient will receive access to both the ATMC Welcome drinks function, and the Official drinks function at no cost. The prize includes the full price of a single ticket only to these events and does not include any food or drinks purchased at the events. If the winner has already purchased tickets to the aforementioned events, then the winner will be entitled to a refund of the full cost of the ticket(s) and no more. The refund of the costs associated will occur no later than the final day of the conference, 16 September 2022. Actual/appraised value may differ at the time of prize award. The specifics of the prize shall be solely determined by the Australian Tactical Medical Association. No cash or other prize substitution is permitted except at the Sponsor's discretion. The prize is non-transferable. Any and all prize-related expenses, including without limitation any and all federal, state, and/or local taxes, shall be the sole responsibility of the winner. No substitution of prize or transfer/assignment of prize to others or request for the cash equivalent by winners is permitted. Acceptance of the prize constitutes permission for the Australian Tactical Medical Association to use the winner's name, likeness, and entry for purposes of advertising and trade without further compensation unless prohibited by law.

6. Odds: The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

7. Winner selection and notification: Winners of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition will be selected in a random drawing under the supervision of the Sponsor. Winners will be announced on ATMA Social Media channels and notified via email to the email address they entered The ATMC22 Ticket Competition within five (5) days following the winner selection. The Australian Tactical Medical Association shall

have no liability for a winner's failure to receive notices due to the winner's spam, junk e-mail or other security settings or for the winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information. If the selected winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the prize within 15 days from the time award notification was sent, or fails to timely return a completed and executed declaration and releases as required, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected.

The receipt by the winner of the prize offered in The ATMC22 Ticket Competition is conditioned upon compliance with any and all federal and state laws and regulations. ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY ANY WINNER (AT THE SPONSOR'S SOLE DISCRETION) WILL RESULT IN SUCH WINNER'S DISQUALIFICATION AS WINNER OF THE SWEEPSTAKES, AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.

8. Rights Granted by you: By entering The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, you understand that the Australian Tactical Medical Association, anyone acting on behalf of the Australian Tactical Medical Association, or its respective licensees, successors and assigns will have the right, where permitted by law, without any further notice, review or consent to print, publish, broadcast, distribute, and use, worldwide in any media now known or hereafter in perpetuity and throughout the World, your entry, including, without limitation, the entry and winner's name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, image or statements about The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, and biographical information as news, publicity or information and for trade, advertising, public relations and promotional purposes without any further compensation.

9. Terms: The Australian Tactical Medical Association reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend The ATMC22 Ticket Competition should (in its sole discretion) a virus, bugs, non-authorized human intervention, fraud or other causes beyond its control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or proper conduct of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition. In such a case, the Australian Tactical Medical Association may select the recipients from all eligible entries received prior to and/or after (if appropriate) the action taken by the Australian Tactical Medical Association. The Australian Tactical Medical Association reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers or attempts to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the ATMC22 Ticket Competition or website or violates these Terms & Conditions.

The Australian Tactical Medical Association has the right, in its sole discretion, to maintain the integrity of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, to void votes for any reason, including, but not limited to; multiple entries from the same user from

different IP addresses; multiple entries from the same computer in excess of that allowed by sweepstakes rules; or the use of bots, macros or scripts or other technical means for entering.

Any attempt by an entrant to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of The ATMC22 Ticket Competition may be a violation of criminal and civil laws, and should such an attempt be made, the Australian Tactical Medical Association reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.

As a condition of participating in The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, the Participant agrees that any and all disputes which cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or connected with The ATMC22 Ticket Competition, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in Queensland having jurisdiction. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will the participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including reasonable attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (i.e. costs associated with entering The ATMC22 Ticket Competition). The participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
